Dr. Heng received his DVM from the Universiti Pertanian Malaysia. He continued his studies in the field of veterinary diagnostic imaging at the University of Melbourne. Upon completion of his study in Australia, he was appointed as a lecturer at Universiti Pertanian Malaysia.

Dr. Heng then completed his radiology residency and master's degree combination program at Colorado State University. As a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Radiology and the European College of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging, he worked at Purdue University from 2007 to 2021, where he was Clinical Professor of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging, section chief of diagnostic imaging and director of ACVR residency program before joining VetCT. In this current position, Dr. Heng is involved in teleradiology and virtual supervision of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging residents of a few universities via the arrangement of VetCT.

Dr. Heng is the author or co-author of over 90 peer-reviewed publications and is widely sought after as speaker in national and international veterinary conferences, other than conducting radiology and ultrasound workshops across the world. He lives in Indiana with his family and enjoys outdoor activities.

Dr. Lim received his DVM from Universiti Putra Malaysia and completed his diagnostic imaging residency at the University of Pretoria. He is a Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging and a Fellow of the Malaysian College of Veterinary Specialists. He was the Chair of the ECVDI Credentials Committee and member of the Executive Committee between 2020-2022, and is currently part of the Selection Committee. Dr. Lim has served as a Clinical Associate Professor of Diagnostic Imaging at Purdue University, USA (2013-2021) and is now a Radiologist with VetCT. He has authored/co-authored over 70 peer-reviewed journal publications and abstract proceedings. Being passionate in teaching and education, he is actively involved in training imaging residents in the US, Canada and UK. He frequently conducts imaging workshops and has spoken at innumerable international conferences. Dr. Lim enjoys travelling with his lovely wife and has a soft spot for Musang King.
